Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing with final travel details for the forthcoming Y6 London Residential Trip.

Travel arrangements

Wednesday 19th June: Please arrive at school at 6.45am, for a 7am departure.

Friday 21st June: Arrival back to school approx. 6.10pm. We will keep you informed on the day if this changes.

Kit list

Children will need a small luggage bag/suitcase and a day rucksack. Children will be expected to carry their own luggage, so please ensure it is not too heavy or large.

Clothing to wear on arrival

T-shirt, jumper, shorts/skirt/trousers, comfortable trainers.

To pack in small day rucksack

- Sun-cream / sun hat / sunglasses
- Light (waterproof) jacket
- Water bottle
- Packed lunch in disposable or recyclable bags/wrapping rather than a lunchbox for Wednesday (a packed lunch will be provided on the other days)
- Spending money (max £10 in small notes/£1 coins) in a named wallet (this is your child's own responsibility)
- Book/pen & paper/playing cards for coach journey
- Inhalers etc... where applicable

To pack in main luggage

- Changes of underwear
- Sleeping attire
- Wash kit & hairbrush
- Smart top (for the theatre)
- Spare T-shirts (or jumper if weather looks to be chilly)
- Spare shorts/skirt/trousers
- (Towels will be provided by the hotel)

Electrical devices/games/cameras and phones are not to be taken and will be confiscated.

If any children need regular medication administered while we are away, please collect an orange form from Mrs Pelosi in the office and give to Mrs Lennon with the clearly labelled medication when you drop your child off.
