Please note:

- All clubs will be charged at **£3.00** per week unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, in which case they are entitled to one free club per half term (with the exception of Cooking Club)
- All clubs have limited spaces available
- Please ensure that payment is paid in advance to secure your child's place
- Please text the school by Tuesday 30th July with the club your child would like to attend. *Text example: George Y3 bellringing*
- All clubs run from 3-4pm

Karaoke: Children will take it in turns to choose and sing songs with the use of microphones. Singing is great fun and scientifically proven to

be good for mental health.

Gardening and Nature: Children will be gardening and talking all things nature and wellbeing with our new volunteer Mrs Lutas who, as well as having a real passion for all things outdoors, is trained in forest school, bush craft and forest therapy. Mrs Lutas is a retired teacher with a long career of working with children; she has recently moved to Brighstone and is keen to get involved in the community and working with children again.

Mindful Arts and Crafts: Quiet and calm time to make things like friendship bracelets, cardboard crafts, greeting cards, Hama beads etc.
